

It's my privilege today to address all our donors and associates for the valuable support we have received over the years. I take this opportunity to congratulate all the staff of ICARE for their excellent and dedicated performance in helping the hospital grow into one of repute.

With modernization and renovation in the hospital, the ambience is one that gives a good feeling to the patients and all who visit the hospital for necessary ICARE.

We achieved the prestigious NABH (National Accreditation Board for hospitals & healthcare Providers) Accreditation in 2016.

As of March 2017, we have conducted 2,40,000 surgeries, and 3.1 million eye screenings. We are aiming to achieve the major milestone of 2,50,000 surgeries during the FY 2017-18.

Our eye examinations are carried out with the latest state of the art equipment and we follow the most sophisticated investigative systems. Our services are on par with the best in the world. We are constantly upgrading our equipment and our processes both in the base hospital at Sec26, our center in Sec 63 Noida and our Rural Outreach Programs.

We do a comprehensive eye examination for all patients of ICARE Eye hospital and spend approx. an hour two hours with each patient. Though time consuming we are able to detect in 15-20% cases, diseases which do not show any symptoms, but could produce serious loss of vision. In such cases of early glaucoma, diabetic retinopathy, Peripheral retinal degeneration complications we suggest prophylactic treatment which, can prevent permanent visual complications, a very satisfying experience for ICARE. This is a very challenging and satisfying experience for ICARE.

Once again, I extend my gratitude to our donors, volunteers, partners and my dear colleagues for tirelessly and compassionately working towards the goal of eradicating avoidable blindness.








In Memoriam

Highlights from the Year 2016-2017

- * ICARE received accreditation from National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare Providers.
- * The Institutional network saw 261360 patients across its primary, secondary and tertiary facilities.
- * 23392 sight restoring surgeries were performed which is one of the highest in North India
- * Of the above overall surgeries 13862 (59%) of these surgeries were done free and 1744 (8%) were subsidized. This again underscores the Institutions commitment to the underprivileged.
- * 7786 (33%) surgeries were performed in the paid wing. The surplus created by the paid work, enabled us to support a major portion of our charitable work.
- * The Eye Banking initiative continued to grow with 129 corneal tissues retrieved by the eye banking team through HCRP (Hospital based Cornea Retrieval Programme) and direct tissue donations.
- * More than 2600 surgeries performed in a month of Feb 2017 a major landmark achieved.











ICARE History

Ishwar Charitable Trust (ICT) was established in 1982 by Dr Sushil Choudhry in his mother's name "Ishwar "with funds left by her Insurance policy.

He started working from his residence and gradually he realized that, with hard work and dedication his dream for Ishwar Charitable Trust would become a reality in the not too distant future. ICARE Eye Hospital was established in 1993 on one acre of land in Noida. Apart from providing comprehensive eye care to patients walking in directly, the centre is also catering to all referral cases coming from Delhi NCR & other states of India. ICARE is a hub of the Training, Research & Quality initiatives. We train not only Doctors completing MBBS for DNB Post Graduate Programme, but also train boys and girls from economically weaker sections (EWS) of society as paramedics.

To cater to the passion of ICARE to treat curable blindness in the most unserved /underserved parts of rural villages around our base hospital we have established rural outreach camps in neighboring states of Rajasthan, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and slum areas of Delhi, to provide modern eye care services literally at their doorsteps.



ICARE Eye Hospital - Our Journey



ICARE Eye Hospital, Khurja, U.P

It has evolved into an advanced secondary centre with the addition of various diagnostic equipments. Since 2014, we have performed 6451 surgeries in this center.

ICARE Eye Hospital, ITS Greater Noida, U.P.

Established in 2014, it is the Second satellite surgical centre of the Institute. The facility today caters to the neighboring villages of Greater Noida and Dadri. The numbers of surgeries conducted in the year reached a high of 3299

ICARE Eye Hospital, Sector - 63, U.P


It is a state of the art facility with a well equipped OT conducting 60 to 65 surgeries per month.



Rural Outreach Program

ICARE Rural Outreach Program is one of its kind. Its aim is to provide modern eye care services at the doorstep of villagers at no or reasonable cost. ICARE provides free eye check ups and surgeries to the people of rural slums who cannot afford the same. Our outreach program has been covering rural areas of Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and economically weaker areas of Delhi.

- 1. 1100 to 1200 camps are conducted every year where patients are identified and counselled by our team.
- 2. The patients are then brought to our base hospital in Noida for surgeries at no cost.
- 3. They stay at the hospital for 3 days where food, surgery, medicine and other necessities are met free of cost.
- 4. Once the surgery is done, the patient is briefed about the aftercare and given medicines for use.
- 5. Our ambulances then drops the patients back to their villages. Over the past 24 years the hospital has been working diligently to provide quality eye care service to all sections of the society irrespective of the person's status.

Screening Camps

ICARE Screening camps are conducted in 30 districts of Haryana, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh. The objective of these screening camps is to identify patients who require ocular services. We conduct these camps across 4 states involving more than 100k patients each year.

Departments And Services

The comprehensive eye care and cataract services are the bedrock of the Institute and expectedly attract the maximum footfalls. This service is available on a continuous basis at all the locations of ICARE Eye Hospital. Across the network, a total of 19692 cataract surgeries were performed out of 23392 surgeries, which involved conventional as well as premium lenses like multifocal and toric.

We are the only hospital in Noida offering bladeless robotic laser cataract and bladeless lasik surgeries.

ICARE boasts of four state of the art operation theatre and well trained technical staff to manage them. Our surgeons have experience of operations on complex surgical cases with the latest technology at par with the best in the country.

At ICARE we have the latest pre diagnostic cataract lab with the Zeiss IOL MASTER 700(OCT based optical barometer) and the ALCON VISION (IMAGE guided cataract) diagnostic platform.

This is the story of little Manisha who belongs to a remote village in Haryana where her parents work as daily wagers. She was 4 years old when she started developing a white spot in her LEFT eye. The parents do not even earn enough to provide food for their 6 children. The kid had cataract and so could not see. The parents were not even aware about the cataract as they are illiterate. We met her at a camp through our rural outreach programme. The father started crying when he was told that the surgery will be done for free and she will be able to see again. Manisha was bought to the base hospital where the surgery was performed successfully. The father's words of 'God Bless you' was our reward. Manisha now goes to school and can see the world.

The Glaucoma specialty services has been growing steadily and is one of the busiest practices at the hospital and receives referrals from North India as well as the Institute's own network. In the past year, it has seen a significant increase in the number of Pediatric Glaucoma surgeries. Dr. Reena Chaudhry received a lot of acclamation for her work in this area. Last year the service had a surgical output of 130 cases. The department has the best diagnostic equipment with well trained staff and excellent doctors to handle the growing need of glaucoma cases. The use of computerized visual field testing; optic nerve imaging and other specialized imaging modalities are put in practice, so that the patients benefit the most.

Saroj a 60 year old female came to us through our outreach program. She was diagnosed with angle closure glaucoma in both eyes, in a very advanced stage in the left eye. She told us that her family cannot even afford three meals a day and she has become a liability to her family. She had laser done in both eyes from somewhere else and was taking treatment also, but her condition became uncontrollable. When she came to us, she underwent a comprehensive glaucoma evaluation. She was advised a combined surgery to save her eye, the same was carried out by our team at ICARE Noida. After surgery the patient gained useful vision with controlled intra ocular pressure. She keeps blessing our team whenever she comes for a follow up.

ICARE EYE HOSPITALS& POST GRADUATE INSTITUTE

The cornea service has been evolving Year on year and has been introducing new surgical techniques for the benefit of those under its care. The department performed 397 surgeries Since April 2016 till March 31, 2017. Some of the surgical techniques introduced in the recent past are DSEK and Boston Keratoprosthesis. It also happens to be one of the busiest practices in North India. The ICARE Eye bank is the only accredited eye bank in the whole of Noida. It is registered with EBSI and UP state government health ministry. It has state of the art facilities including laminar flow hood and special microscope to evaluate the viability of corneas. The Cornea services take care of a variety of issues including ocular surface discards like Stevens Johnson's syndrome, OCP, DRY EYE, Corneal dystrophies. Treatments involve providing solutions using Femto Laser Technology. Since 2008 advance CL ROSE K lens and MINI SCLERAL LENS are also available.





Ram Prasad a 50 year old male lives in a village in Rajasthan. He works as a farmer and has a family of 10 to support. He grows wheat and other crops to feed his family. His kids do not go to school as he does not earn enough. He lost his vision due to an infection and could only see his fingers if held them close to his eyes. He was bought to the base hospital for tests from his village, our specialist diagnosed corneal dystrophy for which he underwent successful Keratoplasty surgery. The patient's vision is back to normal and he is independently supporting his family.



The Oculoplasty and Ocular Oncology


Department caters to and performs cosmetic and reconstructive surgery in and around the eye for conditions like ptosis, eyelid deformities, prominent eye etc. It also runs ancillary services such as Ocular Oncology clinic, Botox Clinic and Custom Ocular Prosthesis Clinic. While the Ocular Oncology Clinic treats patients with tumors of the eye, the Ocular Prosthesis Clinic caters to cosmetic rehabilitation of patients due to tumors and trauma. Last year the department has performed 433 Subspecialty operations.

We present to you the story of Ramesh Chand, 60 yr old elderly gentleman working as a priest in a local religious organization. He came to us with his son to seek treatment at the ITS Branch of ICARE for mass in the lid causing progressive drooping of the upper lid, thinking it to be a non resolving stye. On first contact with our Ophthalmologist at ITS, the patient was aptly sent for treatment to the NOIDA branch suspecting a malignancy or a cancer of the lid. He underwent detailed examinations and then as a part of treatment of the underwent two surgeries involving removal of the entire upper lid and then reconstruction of the lid to restore structure and function. Following the successful treatment for his cancer on the eyelid, he has been showering us with loads of blessing for giving him the gift of life.

ICARE EYE HOSPITALS & POST GRADUATE INSTITUTE

The Pediatric Ophthalmology and Strabismus clinic at the hospital is one of the busiest. In terms of both the volume of referral work that it gets and the ability to handle complex cases, the department has been achieving new landmarks. The Pediatric ophthalmology and strabismus department treats premature infants and children less than 16 years old. Our Kids Vision Club has all required facilities to treat and manage complex vision problems among children. The ailments treated are refractive errors needing eye glasses, amblyopia (lazy eye), strabismus (crossed eyes), eye infections, eye allergies, watering from the eyes due to blocked tear ducts and childhood cataract, besides others. The department co-manages disorders like lid-drooping and retinopathy of prematurity with other specialty departments. The department has a fully functional Orthoptic facility with computerized vision therapy to treat eye muscle weakness. The department performed extensive cataract and 70 squint surgeries.

Seven years old Madhuri studying in class two at a local government school in Bisalpur, Pilibhit, U.P. Her father - Rampal works as a laborer, Madhuri has five more siblings and she is the youngest amongst them.

Madhuri was brought by her father with a complaint of not being able to see properly from her right eye. He still remembers the accident happened with Madhuri in last Diwali, the crackers has taken away the right eye vision. Though he quickly took Madhuri to a local doctor for the medication, the treatment lasted for six months after which she started facing problem in the eye. He brought Madhuri to our camp where screened by the doctor an refereed to the base hospital for the complete treatment. At ICARE examined Madhuri on

17.09.2017 and found that she is suffering from Traumatic Cataract. On examination by ICARE's anesthetist, she was found with severe chest congestion which needed to treated before the surgery. ICARE got her chest treatment from the government hospital, so that her surgery could be carried out. Her Surgery was performed on 23.09.2017 successfully giving her an opportunity to live a normal life.

VITREO RETINAL SERVICES is one of the busiest subspecialties and also one of the best equipped and deals with all kinds of retinal diseases. To its existing complement of high end diagnostic and procedural equipment, it added on two new instruments, a portable B-scan and a 3 chip camera for recording vitreo retinal surgeries in the operation theatre. The camera has enhanced the institute's ability to assess and share complex vitreo-retinal surgeries. The department has always taken the lead to adopt new techniques to provide the best possible outcome to patients under its care. We use latest techniques to provide Stitch less Micro Incision Vitrectomy Surgeries (MIVS) comprising of 23-25 gauge which are being done in the majority of vitreo retinal surgeries. This decreases the complications and duration of the surgeries. MIVS also provides greater postoperative comfort, better cosmetic and early rehabilitation of the patients. Several combined penetrating keratoplasty and vitreo retinal surgeries were also done using temporary keratoprosthesis. The department performed 1594 sub specialty operations in 2016-17.

Seema Devi was bought to the base camp by our team. She had a damaged cornea. The only solution was surgery where a new corneal tissue had to be put in her eye replacing the damaged tissue. Seema devi who lived in Badarpur had one son who had abandoned her saying she could not see now, so was a liability. With no financial and emotional support she had accepted her condition as permanent. Our team gave her hope and assurance that after the surgery she will be able to see again. Keratoplasty was performed on her left eye at ICARE Noida free of cost. A graft was taken from person who had passed away with no known diseases or other factors from our Eye Bank. Surgery was carried out successfully and Seema Devi can see now and is working as a maid in a school. Her life has changed and her smile says it all.



Refractive Services in today's fast paced life full of stress where people are tired of wearing glasses or contact lenses seek the help of refractive surgeons. Refractive surgery improves vision by correcting refractive errors such as nearsightedness (myopia), farsightedness (hyperopic) and astigmatism. These minimally invasive procedures use cold laser to reshape the cornea to correct the above mentioned refractive errors. We at ICARE have the best refractive surgical team with state of the art equipment to perform surgeries giving the patient the best results.

ICARE is the only eye hospital in Noida which offers BLADE FREE Lasik surgeries. We performed 209 Refractive surgeries in the last financial year.

ELECTROPHYSIOLOGY SERVICES

Electrophysiology testing includes a battery of tests which can be used to provide information about the visual system beyond the standard clinical examination of the eye. Tests like Electroretinogram (ERG), Multifocal ERG (MFERG), Visual Evoked Potentials (VEP), Electro-oculogram (EOG) are performed to assess the condition.

Mateena is a 14 year old child, who came to our camp in Mewat. She came to us with inability to see with both eyes. She was bought to our base hospital, and our doctors examined her and diagnosed that both eyes had cataract, chronic uveitis vitreous hemorrhage and retinal detachment. Systematic evaluation and tests revealed that this was a result of ocular tuberculous. She was started on a anti TB therapy by our physician. We performed left eye surgery followed by right eye cataract surgery free of cost as she belongs to a poor family who could not afford the surgery cost. Now she has limited vision and she and her father never thought that she would see again. She still can't believe it that she can see and has now started living a better life.




Eye Bank

Research

Research and clinical trials remain a focus area for all subspecialties. A clinical trial involves research participants. It follows a pre-defined plan or protocol to evaluate the effects of a medical or behavioral intervention on health outcomes. By taking part in clinical trials, participants not only play a more active role in their own health care, but they also can access experimental treatments and help others by contributing to medical research. The clinical depth, large base of patients and a strong ethical framework attracts pharmaceutical, biotechnology companies and other collaborators.

The IRB (Institutional Review Board) vets the research ideas developed by various disciplines. The Ethics Committee, working as per the guidelines of ICH-GCP, Schedule Y and all applicable local regulatory requirements, oversees patient safety, patient rights and maintenance of good clinical practices.



ICARE Eye Hospital & Post graduate Institute Ethics Committee has been registered to Drug Controller General of India (DCGI) till June 2019

Phacoemulsification Training Program

Phacoemulsification Training Program is comprehensive and has been running successfully at ICARE.

Some Salient Features of this Program are

- * Training is done on ALCON Laureate Peristialtic Pump Phaco machines.
- * The trainees initially are made to observe the surgical consultants perform phacoemulsification surgeries on patients, following which they perform surgeries under supervision of the consultants.
- * The training is done over a period of 2 weeks.
- * The trainees are required to first meet & examine the patients before performing surgery followed by post operative checkups.
- * The ophthalmologist (consultant) delivers lectures to trainees making sure they understand the process of patient selection, steps in surgery and all other aspects associated with the OT training.
- * Each surgery by the trainees is video recorded. The recordings are later used for discussion with the trainees during their training classes.
- * Regular classes on topics ranging from wound construction, pre-opt patient selection, CCC & hydro, nucleus management, complication management etc.
- * Each day the trainees are also given exposure in the wet lab to learn & perform surgeries on goat's eye to enhance their surgical skills.







DNB Post Graduate Program

Features of DNB programme:

CLINICAL

It deals with training the candidate to examine patients present in the OPD. They are taught basics such as refraction followed by slit lamp examinations. Handling all ophthalmic instruments is covered in the post graduation course.

ACADEMICS :

The academic curriculum includes didactic lectures thrice a week, case presentations by the PG doctors at least once a week, journal club presentations every alternate week & early morning ward lectures thrice a week. The post graduates are regularly posted on rotational basis among the various specialized OPD's.

LOGBOOK

: Appraisal of log book and attendance is carried out every 3 months.

SURGICAL EXPERTISE

The candidates are then posted in the Operation Theatre (OT), on a rotational basis and during these postings each candidate is exposed to a stepwise presurgical and post-surgical work up. Stepwise surgical exposure is given under the expert supervision of a consultant surgeon. Only when the candidate is found to be well versed in all the surgical procedures are they allowed to perform independent surgeries.

THESIS

The thesis preparation begins from the day a PG doctor joins ICARE where it is decided by the academic head the topic for his/her and guided by our consultants, who then ensure that the thesis are completed on time and on the guidelines laid down by NBE.

ROASTERING:

Candidates are required to diligently attend to patients in the community wing & camps attending to 300-350 patients a day.

Vision Technician Courses

In India, presently there is a great shortage of trained human resources to meet the requirement of healthcare. For eye care itself, India has a grave shortage of ophthalmologists- 0.8 per 100,000, as compared to the WHO mandate of 2 per 100,000. Further, as of 2012 India has only 13,678 optometrists2 for a blind population of almost 15 million. This is likely to get further aggravated as the population ages and the existing available trained human resources are unable to cope with the rising demand of the elderly population for such nursing care. Moreover, because of the shortage the services of existing trained resources are very expensive.

On the flipside, India has a large young population which is unproductive due to lack of education or skills. Most of these children belong to poor, underprivileged families with minimal resources for basic necessities, let alone their education and training.
